CommuteSmart even works hand-in-hand with companies and organizations to develop tailored commuter programs. Oh yeah, did we mention you get paid just by logging your commutes on our website? CommuteSmart is the smarter way to work every day!



Walking to work not only helps reduce emissions and traffic congestion, but it also promotes a healthy lifestyle. There are no limitations on how far you have to walk.



Vanpooling is a popular alternative for individuals who live and work in the same vicinity and can save you money just by reducing the wearand-tear on your car.



Transit riders are also eligible for incentives through the CommuteSmart program. Just tell us when you ride!



Biking to and from work is a healthy alternative to commute that also helps reduce vehicle emissions. There are no limitations on the distance you have to travel.



Teleworking (or working from home) makes you eligible for incentives through the CommuteSmart program. It also reduces vehicle emissions by getting your car off the road.



Carpooling with a friend, coworker or spouse to and from work is not only cost saving, but it makes your commute more fun. You don't have to carpool every day, and there are no limitations on the distance you must travel. We even have a database with more than 15,000 participants looking for a ridematch if you think you can't find one.



How do I get paid to commute?

GetGreen A COMMUTESMART PROGRAM

GetGreen is a one-time program that offers commuters \$1 per day for every day an alternative commute is taken in the first 90 days of participating in CommuteSmart. Each commuter is eligible to receive up to \$70 during this period. Commuters are paid for each day they choose to carpool, telework, take transit, bike or walk to work. A minimum of 20 alternative commutes must be taken during the 90-day period to qualify for a check (this would equal a \$20 check). After you have completed the GetGreen program, you will automatically be enrolled into CommuterClub. Vanpool participants are not eligible for this program.

Commuter Club

After the initial 90-day period of the GetGreen program, commuters are automatically enrolled in the ongoing CommuterClub program. "Club members" who log at least 20 qualified commutes over a three-month period will receive a \$25 gift card of their choice every 90 days. Each carpooler that logs their commutes is eligible for a gift card. Commutes are not based on distance from home to work. Qualified commute alternatives are carpooling, teleworking, taking transit, biking and walking to work. Vanpool participants are not eligible for this program.

Emergency RIDE HOME

Any commuter actively logging commutes in the CommuteSmart database is eligible for the Emergency Ride Home program. If an emergency arises while you are at work, CommuteSmart will set you up with a free ride home. This program only covers emergencies such as sickness while at work or unexpected overtime up to five times per year.

*Commuters living or working in Jefferson or Shelby counties are eligible for the CommuteSmart program!
